Restrictions	Bachelor students are not allowed to take courses of our Master programmes. Exception: If students are enrolled in a 4-year Bachelor programme and are in their final year.
Restricted Master programmes	Erasmus students have no access to: M.Sc. Environmental Governance (MEG)
Registration for courses	Erasmus students do not need to register for courses themselves. A few weeks before the semester starts we send an up-to-date course catalogue and ask to check and confirm their selection. We then book the places. In some cases a course maybe be fully booked by regular students. In this case, we offer alternatives.

German language courses	Erasmus students have free access to German courses provided by the The Language Teaching Centre (SLI) of the University of Freiburg . Registration for courses in winter semester opens mid-September, for summer semester at the beginning of March. .

ECTS CREDITS

Credits per semester	25-30 ECTS is the standard full-time semester load for degree seeking students.
Credits per course / module	One course/module equals 5 ECTS credits, in both, Bachelor and Master programmes.

HOUSING

Student residences	After registration in the Mobility Online Portal students can apply online for housing in a student residence. If Erasmus students apply right away, it is very likely that they get a place. Prices range from 280€ to 450€ per month.
Private housing	It is very difficult to find a room on the private market. We strongly recommend to apply for a student residence.
